Fr. Larry's Weekly Letter #561

PEACE BE WITH YOU



This Sunday's gospel takes to the Upper Room where the disciples are all gathered after the death of Jesus. They are still hiding, and filled with fear and shame. They are embarrassed and paralyzed by their cowardice and betrayal. Jesus had died and they did nothing to protect him.

The two disciples who met Jesus on the road to Emmaus tell their companions the good news of Jesus' resurrection.

Then Jesus suddenly appears in their midst. The disciples think that they are seeing a ghost. He shows them the wounds from his crucifixion that serve as his identification card.

The disciples deserved his anger but he didn't criticize them or make them feel any worse than they already did. He didn't condemn them for being weak.

Instead, Jesus surprised them with a greeting of peace and a request for food. Their brokenness wasn't terminal. Jesus started the healing process.

Have you ever felt the way the disciples did? Maybe you are in the midst of a painful situation right now that has you feeling confused, betrayed or lost. Maybe a traumatic experience still haunts you. Or maybe the guilt of some past sin continues to weigh you down.

The disciples were very different people after meeting the post-resurrection Jesus. He offered them the possibility of a fresh start, and so they started to grow through their weakness. Their brokenness became something beautiful and a lasting example of healing and new beginnings.

Jesus's invitation to his disciples is also offered to us. Even with all our faults, failures and shortcomings Jesus can repair and make us even more beautiful.

Jesus longs to do for us today what he did for his disciples. He longs to open our mind to his mercy so that we can be set free from guilt or shame. He longs to reveal his love so that we can see past our painful past. He wants us to receive his mercy and compassion so that we can look into the future with hope and trust. He wants us to move on!

Quiet your heart today so that you can hear Jesus speak to you. Let him give you, his peace.

One of the Easter cards that I received this year had this beautiful and hopeful message.

The resurrection tells us it is never too late. Every so often we will be surprised. We must believe that the stone will be rolled back, and we must be ready to... take off the linen bindings of death and walk free... breathing resurrection air.



What is a Mass Intention?

Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph parish offers the possibility for you to request that a Mass be celebrated for a particular intention. Requesting a Mass intention means that you are asking that the grace of Christ's sacrifice in his death and resurrection be applied for a particular purpose, for example, for a deceased person or a living person who is ill or in thanksgiving for a favor received. An intention can also be made for an occasion of a birthday, anniversary or special need, or it can be directed to a cause, such as an increase of vocations or respect for life. Usually, a single intention is attached to a given Mass. But it is also possible to gather several intentions in one Mass with exactly the same effect.
